Violence in the territory: The case of Colombia

- Date:** 21 and 29 March 2023
- Time:** 10.30 (morning session) 16:00 (afternoon session)
- Location:** Gizalde San Sebastián Gipuzkoa
- Objective:** Debating violence in the north/south territories. Analysing the case of Colombia and the way in which some people have been violently attacked and expelled from their territory for defending their territorial rights, whether individual or collective property, and for defending natural resources. Violence against their bodies and their voices is the strategy used by illegal groups, as well as national and multinational companies, who have used the expropriation and usurpation of individual and collective territory by blood and fire in Colombia.
- Methodology:** Analysis of the documentary video: Voices and Bodies: Violence in the Territory, Case of Colombia. Discussion groups to understand, analyse and explore in greater depth the lived realities of the participants.

Territory and borders: migratory corridors

- Date:** 28 September
- Time:** 16.30 to 18:14
- Location:** Gizalde San Sebastián Gipuzkoa
- Objective:** To expose the most dangerous land migration route in the world, the Central American migration corridor, being the most visible migrant caravan that aims to reach the United States. According to the IOM (International Organization for Migration), since 2018 to date 258 people have been killed / 41 are minors.
- Methodoly:** Life story of a migrant person who has arrived in the host country in the USA using this route, as a basis for developing empathetic groups of analysis of this life experience.
- Date:** 29 September
- Time:** 9:30 to 12:30
- Location:** Ángeles Custodios School Bilbao Bizkaia
- Objective:** To raise awareness of the most dangerous maritime migratory route, the Mediterranean corridor where 27,844 people have left their lives since 2014 to date.
- Methodology:** Life story of an immigrant person who has arrived in the host country Bizkaia (Euskadi) using this route as a basis for developing empathetic analysis groups of this life experience.
